

# ***Porphyra* – International e-journal in Byzantine Studies**

*Editorial rules (valid from September 2016)*

All proposals sent to *Porphyra's* editorial board and scientific committee must respect editorial rules and be submitted within the deadlines in order to be considered for publication. Manuscripts should also be fully copy-edited and spell-checked. All contributions will undergo a process of *double blind peer-review*.

Any variation to the aforementioned norms must be thoroughly discussed and approved (in a written form) by the editorial board.

## ***Proposals for articles***

All proposals must be complete of:

- **title;**
- **name of author;**
- **academic affiliation** (if applicable);
- a **short abstract** (150 words max.), in the same language of the article or in English;
- **3-5 key words.**

Articles should be written in Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5 line spacing and consistency throughout the whole contribution is mandatory.

Articles must be submitted to the editorial board as both pdf and word files.

Footnotes should follow the American abbreviation system: works must be cited with the author's surname (**small caps**), followed by the year of publication (in case of two or more works by the same author published in the same year, letters should be added after) and page number.

E.g.:

ODORICO 1986, 23;

MULLETT 2000, 101-128;

MESSIS-PAPAIOANNOU 2014, 210;

NILSSON 2015a, 15 and NILSSON 2015b, 235.

At the end of the manuscript a complete list of the works cited should be provided. The latter should be in alphabetical order (by author surname) and, for the works by the same author, in chronological order (from oldest to most recent article).

Sources must be cited as in the following examples:

INITIAL AND SURNAME OF AUTHOR [[SMALL CAPS]], *Title of work* [[italics]], in [[roman]] INITIAL(S) AND SURNAME(S) OF EDITOR(S) [[SMALL CAPS]] (ed./edd.), *Title of collection* [[italics]], further details of collection [[roman]], number of volume in roman numbers [[roman]], place and date of publication [[roman]] (*if applicable series* [[italics]], *number of series* [[roman]]), pages [[roman]]

#### ***Proposals for reviews***

Rules are the same as those applicable to articles. The title should be that of the work under review, followed by all necessary information (number of pages, cost and ISBN code).

If necessary, footnotes are allowed; to cite further bibliography, the rules are the same as those indicated for articles, followed by a list of works cited.

Reviews must be submitted to the editorial board as both pdf and word files.

*The aforementioned editorial rules replace all previous ones, which are no longer valid.*
